In connection with the signing on this date of the Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement (TPP Agreement), I have the honour to confirm the following agreement reached between representatives of the Government of the United States of America (United States) and the Government of the Republic of Chile (Chile):

Notwithstanding Article 1.2 (Relation to Other Agreements) of the TPP Agreement, the United States and Chile agree that Article 17.10.2(b) and (c) of the *United States – Chile Free Trade Agreement* is superseded by Article 18.53.1(a) (Measures Relating to the Marketing of Certain Pharmaceutical Products), 18.53.1(b) and 18.53.1(c) of the TPP Agreement.

I have the honour to propose that this letter and your letter of confirmation in reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments, subject to dispute settlement under Chapter 28 (Dispute Settlement) of the TPP Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of entry into force of the TPP Agreement as between the United States and Chile.
